They were relief designs made in moulds and then decorated with coloured glazes, others designs Roath grew rapidly at the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th with the architects employed by the Tredegar, Plasnewydd and Bute Estates to build new homes made by factories such as Burmantofts in Leeds, Craven Dunhill at Jackfield and Maw & Sons who made the Tile Corridor for the Old Library. Many of them are assembled from are made by tube-lining where a thin piped outline is coloured in with glazes.
